1	long sleeve shirt	<i>for art</i>
1	ring binder	<i>hard covered – with 4 rings</i>
100	document wallets	<i>clear plastic – for ring binder</i>
1	plastic pocket with elastic	<i>2-3 cm depth – for homework</i>
3	pens	<i>3 different colours: red, blue, black</i>
2	“Tip-X” or “White out”	<i>to make corrections when writing in pen</i>
2	boxes of tissues	
1	translation dictionary	<i>your child’s native language into English</i>
1	English dictionary	<i>for homework – child edition</i>
1	English thesaurus	<i>for homework – child edition</i>
